


Wesley House, Leeson Park

- 4 twin study-bedrooms (allocated on an individual basis)
- The student leader's room
- Always-on broadband internet access (via WiFi network)
- A community area comprising:
 - Dining area/kitchen & a living area (a television with a cable channel package is provided; TVs are not permitted in the study-bedrooms)
 - 2 toilets and showers
 - Laundry area with washing machine and tumble dryer

Dublin city centre is less than a twenty minute walk from Wesley House and a network of cycle lanes has been developed throughout many parts of the city (facilities are available for the storage of bicycles). In addition, the nearest 'dublinbikes' station (a self-service bike rental system) is less than 5 minutes away.



Location

- Students will be responsible for looking after the communal areas.
- Cost of room includes the electricity, central heating & internet etc.
- Residents need to provide their own bedding, towels, tea-towels, crockery, cutlery and cooking utensils.
- Friends are welcome to visit the community area but should have left by 12 midnight.



- Alcohol, tobacco and illegal substances are not permitted on the premises.
- Residents are strongly advised to take out an "all risks" insurance policy as Wesley House insurance does not cover residents' personal items.
- Student Accommodation is accessible only by stairs.
- The Student Residence may be available for use during the Summer months by application.
